He studied at the Academy of Music. Fryderyk Chopin in Warsaw, where he graduated from the piano under the direction of Jerzy Lefeld and Regina Smendzianka (1968) and composition in the class of Witold Rudziński (1972). In the years 1973-1976 as a scholarship holder of the Fundacja im. Fulbright studied composition (Samuel Adler) and piano (Eugen List) at the Eastman School of Music in Rochester, New York

(USA) receiving a doctorate (Doctor of Musical Arts, 1976). In addition, he participated in the International Competitions of New Music in Darmstadt (Germany) and in the years 1976-1997 he lectured in piano and composition at the international summer camp in Interlochen, Michigan (USA).

He played and lectured in over 50 American universities and participated in many European international music festivals. He is the laureate of the second prize at the International Competition for Performers of Contemporary Music in Rotterdam (1970). As a composer, he was awarded prizes and distinctions at composers' competitions, and his works are often performed at festivals both nationally and abroad. For his artistic activity abroad, he was awarded the diploma of recognition by the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Poland (1990) and the Golden Cross of Merit. He performed in most of Europe, Asia, South America, Cuba, Mexico, Jamaica and the USA.

Professor Andrzej Dutkiewicz in the years 1999-2005 he was dean of the Piano, Harpsichord and Organ Department of the Music Academy. Fryderyk Chopin. Until 2012, he was the head of the Interdepartmental Study of New Music. Since 2000, he has been the artistic director of the summer festival and the music course "From Chopin to Górecki" organized by the FCUM in cooperation with the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage.
